Conditions for the postponement of the maturity of the Pfandbriefe	The postponement of the maturity date is necessary to avoid the insolvency of the Pfandbrief bank with limited business activities (prevention of insolvency), the Pfandbrief bank with limited business activities is not overindebted (no existing overindebtedness) and there is reason to believe that the Pfandbrief bank with limited business activities will be able to meet its liabilities then due at any rate after expiry of the maximum possible postponement period, taking into account further postponement possibilities (positive fulfillment forecast). See also, in addition, section 30 (2b) PfandBG.	
Powers of the cover pool administrator in the event of postponement of the maturity of the Pfandbriefe	The cover pool administrator may postpone the due dates of the redemption payments if the relevant requirements pursuant to Sec. 30 (2b) PfandBG are met. The administrator shall determine the postponement period, which may not exceed 12 months, in accordance with necessity.	
	The cover pool administrator may postpone the due dates of principal and interest payments falling due within one month of his appointment to the end of this monthly period. If the cover pool administrator decides in favor of such a postponement, the existence of the prerequisites pursuant to § 30 par. 2b PfandBG shall be irrefutably presumed.
